

April 11, 2018, General Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 A.M. The word for the day was "Block". Deb Cooper asked us all to "Listen with your whole heart". The minutes from March were approved. The treasurer's report was given by Jan Trimble: Checking account stands at \$30,118.52, and the CD is 9,118.41.

The Board requests that "New Business" be brought to the Board for approval, before announcements are made, in an effort to shorten the length of announcements on regular meeting days. This will ensure that "New Business" will only be announced at the business meeting. The 2021 Raffle Quilt suggestion was accepted; that applique work from Jerri Height, a deceased member of SBSQC, would be used as the basis for the raffle quilt.

The Vice President, Barbara McArthur, made the announcement that only 2 more people are needed to fill the St. Andrews retreat scheduled for August 20-23. The cost is \$320.00 with a deposit of \$100.00 required and the balance due on August 1, 2018. It was decided at the board meeting that attendance would be offered to anyone outside the club and advertised at the local quilt shops. Kamp-Sew-A lot, scheduled for May 21-23, is Full, with a waiting list. All attendees are asked to sign up for KP duty or one of the other jobs to help make it a success. Gladis Marr and Pepai Whipple are in charge of signing up volunteers for demonstrations at Kamp-Sew-A lot. Volunteers are asked to contact them.

Committee chairs made various announcements:

Mary Ann Clayton told us the Raffle Sales were going well and reminded anyone who wished to purchase tickets, that they were available today. Sharon Clayton asked anyone who wishes to sell items in the Country Store that they need to attend one of three meetings for training. The dates scheduled are May 9, May 30, and June 13, 2018. May 16th is the date scheduled at Karen's Quilt Shop for Marilyn Williams and Sharon Clayton's class on Machine Embroidery. Judy Ramos, in charge of the Quilt Challenge, explained the procedure to us. The entries need to be turned in before the show, so that members can vote on their favorites. Then they will be hung at the show for the public viewing. The entry can be ANY book title and your interpretation of that title. Sandy Foster reminded the members that Sue's Sew Day is next week, either buy your lunch from Sandy, soup and salad, or bring your own sack lunch. Gail VanHorsen is leading a "Finish your UFO'S" program. Members are to bring 2 unfinished projects and participants will vote on which choice is to be finished within the next year. Janet Green announced Art Quilt Sue's will meet this afternoon at Karen's Quilt Shop. Brianne Moores, head of the Quilt Show, asked members to please sign up for duties at the show. Sherry Nagel announced the class by Hollis Chatelain to be held November 16-18, 2018, at the Grange. There will be a trunk show and lecture session on Saturday, November 17th. Bonnie Filgo told us she and Barbara Richardson will be taking pictures of entries for the quilt show each week.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:45A.M. We followed the meeting with Birthday acknowledgements and "Show and Tell" by members.
