Janet Lenfant gave the Vice President's report. The Grange rental has been increased for the 4 day time period of October 22-25, 2018. They were asking each person attending to help cover the additional cost by donating another \$5.00.

Mary Anne Clayton asked all members to purchase at least \$10.00 worth of Raffle tickets for 2019. Loretta Bilow expressed the need for stuffed animals to go with the Joy Quilts. Bianne Moores discussed the 2019 Quilt Show and need for volunteers to help existing committee heads. Susan Bremel's announcement regarding identifying Community Quilts as a standing committee, was a notification that a motion and vote will be made at the October, 2018, Business meeting to change the ByLaws.
