Ready to have some fun? This month we are providing you with the fabric requirements for "It's Mystery". Remember this is a two color quilt with a light background.

Fabric Requirements:

Background fabric (light)	2 ½ yards
Medium light Color One	¾ yard
Medium light Color Two	¾ yard
Medium Dark Color One	1 ¾ yards
Medium Dark Color Two	¾ yard
Binding	½ yard

Notes on fabric selection:

1. There should be a clear contrast between the background fabric and the medium lights.
2. Color One and Color Two should play well together. Not sure? Ask a friend. Dig out your color wheel. Ask someone of whom you admire his or her quilts. The library also has several books on color selection in quilts.
3. Color One will have the most playing time on your quilt.

4. You can use scraps in Color One (also Color Two) but you need to make sure they are the same value. Not sure? Lay your fabrics out and take a photo of your choices with your phone or camera. Change it to a grey scale/tonal. When you do this, the one that is not the same value will pop out.



In this fabric selection, I'm not sure about the Medium Dark in Color Number One. It's the same **value** as Medium Dark color Number Two, but it's going to be chopped up. Will the large print design read a different value once it is in the quilt?

Having ask and answered this question, I dug a little further and found my final fabric selection.
