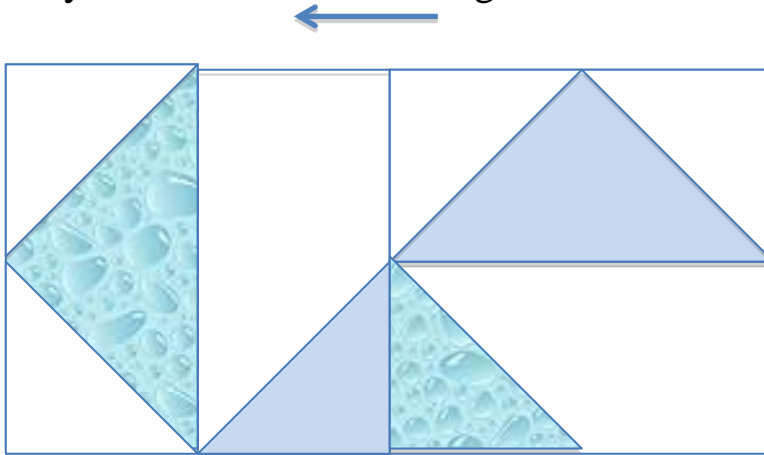

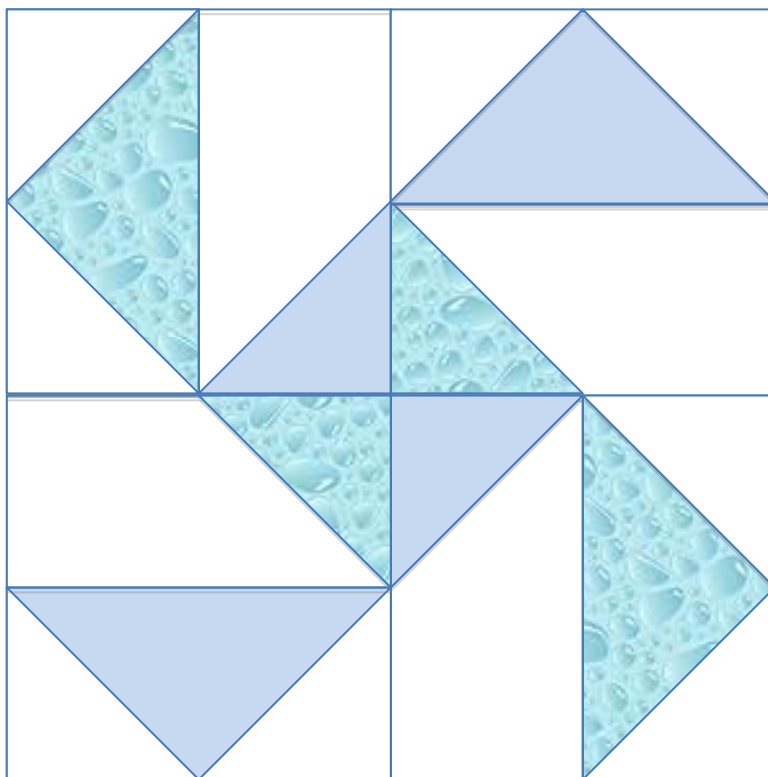
Step Five

Ready to make a block? In this month's instructions we will put together the units made in Step four.

1. Sew two of the units together like the drawing below. Repeat until you have used all of your units. Press to the goose with one wing.



2. Now sew the units together like the drawing below.



3. Voila! You should have 13 blocks measuring  $8\frac{1}{2}$  by  $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".

This block is known as Next Door Neighbor. If the units were assembled differently, it could be Seesaw.
