In the meantime...

I hope you're all ready for this month's beautiful block; it's called the HOPE OF HARTFORSHIRE STAR. This is an interesting block to make because there are two different ways you can place your fabric pieces resulting in two different versions of the same block. In addition, you'll end up with extra units to use for completing the second version. Also, in the construction of this block, I will be introducing the "partial seam". I think you're going to like this one so I hope you can join me.

Below are photos of the two versions of the same block and the diagram for the piecing. As I mentioned above, the second version can be made with the left-over units from the first version. Note that the second version is an incomplete block because I wanted to show only the leftover units without the additional pieces needed to complete the block

You'll need 3 different fabrics: 1 bold; 1 medium (or bright), and 1 background.

Bold: Cut 4 @ 5 3/4" sq.

Med.: Cut 2 @ 6 1/8" sq.

Med.: Cut 1 @ 2 3/4" sq.

Background: Cut 2 @ 6 1/8" sq.

Background: Cut 4 @ 2 3/4" x 5 3/8" rectangle
