

## MAY BOM

Well, my dear friends, I hope you're having fun with the BOMs. I have a new, great, traditional block to demonstrate for you this month. It's the gorgeous DRESDEN PLATE block; but were giving it a bit of a make-over. I think you're going to like it.

I'm going to be presenting 3 versions of this block. You're going to need to make your own templates for this. The dimensions for drafting your own templates are below. Please note that **templates include seam allowance**. For each block, you'll need 16 wedges/petals. Templates can be made with plastic template material which can be purchased at craft stores, cardboard, freezer paper, or even dressmaking pattern-drafting material.

The fabric for this block can be anything you want. Also, below are photos of the 3 versions of this block so you can decide what fabrics will work best for your interpretation of the block. Most of you know that for a successful block you usually need contrast and attention to color values (dark/light fabrics).
