

## JULY 2021 BOM: ROLLING STAR

Get ready for another beautiful BOM. This block is called “ROLLING STAR”. It looks complex because it has lots of small pieces. Do not fear; once you join those small pieces to form “units”, it goes together easily. The block consists of 4 flying geese, squares, and half-square triangles.

In the demo I’ll show you how to organize your fabric pieces to simplify the construction process. Fabric choices are key to this particular block to give it the interesting dimensional look. I’ve provided a “fabric key” diagram to help organize your fabric cuts and their corresponding placement. Please refer to this diagram when cutting and arranging your fabrics.

You’ll need 4 fabrics: Light background fabric, Bright fabric, Medium fabric, Very Dark fabric.

Flying Geese: For the Geese - Fabric **B** - 1 @ 5 1/4” sq.

For the Sky - “ **A** - 4 @ 2 7/8” sq.

Squares: Fabric **A** - 8 @ 2 1/2” sq.

Half-Square Triangles: Fabric **A/B** - 4 @ 2 7/8”

“ **B/D** - 2 @ 2 7/8”

“ **B/C** - 2 @ 2 7/8”

“ **C/D** - 2 @ 2 7/8”
