Community Quilt in One Size

Comfort quilt size – 36 by 45 inches

Fabric:

Center blocks: 1/2 yard each of two fabrics (A and B)

Sashing blocks: 1 yard

Binding: 1/2 yard

If using the same fabric for sashing and binding you need only 1-1/4 yards total.

Cutting:

Center blocks – 20 total needed, 10 of each of Fabric A and Fabric B. From WOF cut two 6-1/2 strips of Fabric A and subcut into squares 6-1/2 inches wide. Repeat with Fabric B. (You will have extra squares of each fabric.)

Sashing blocks, cut 9 WOF strips 3-1/2 inches wide. Subcut into 20 rectangles 6-1/2 inches long, and 20 other rectangles 9-1/2 inches long.

Assembly:

Sew one 6-1/2 sashing strip to the top or bottom of a square and then sew a 9-1/2 inch sashing strip to the side of the resulting block. The final block should measure 9-1/2 inches. Repeat for all 20 blocks.

Alternate the Fabric A block with the Center Block up and the Fabric B block with the Center Block at the bottom. There are four blocks across and five rows down.
