## BRIC-A-BRAC

While the term means "miscellaneous objects or ornaments of little value", we are making bricks out of those miscellaneous fabric scraps that live in our stashes!

FINISHED SIZE: 39" x 51"
FABRIC REQUIREMENTS: (This is a scrappy quilt)
16 small bricks cut 7 1/2" $\times 4$ 1/2"
12 large bricks cut 10 1/2" x 4 1/2"
1 yard solid or read-as-solid fabric
Cut nine $21 / 2$ " strips x WoF for the sashing and five 2 1/2" strips for the borders.
Sub-cut two of the strips into $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2$ " rectangles for the mortar between the bricks. Two strips should yield 18 of the 20 needed. Cut the last two off two ends of horizontal sashes.

Rows 1, 3, 5 and 7: Join four small bricks with mortar sashes in-between

Rows 2, 4, 6 and 8:
Join three large bricks with mortar sashes in-between.

Join rows together, adding sashing between each row.

Add borders to the sides then to the top and bottom.
(This sample shows a contrasting border.
To do this, you would need 1/2 yard for sashes and 1/3 yard for borders.)
