

Book Donation Guidelines

The library volunteers are truly appreciative of contributions of used books. Re-selling these donated items provides the funds necessary to purchase new books for our library. Please remember that any books that we cannot sell, we must deal with in other ways. This has been a problem in the past.

This year we will be trying some new things in hopes of selling used books. To start with, each week we will be offering a selection of books to members asking for a free-will donation in exchange. Other means of getting good books into the hands of members will follow.

Here are guidelines to help you determine which books to donate to the library for resale:

- Books with a copywrite date of 2010 or later
- Books in good condition – clean and undamaged
- Books on Quilting and quilting-associated needlework

The following are items that are not to be donated to the library at this time:

- Books with a copywrite date of 2009 or earlier
- Damaged books
- Books on subjects that are not related to quilting or quilting-associated needlework
- Magazines, pamphlets and folders
- Fiction
- Rare or valued books either historical or research in nature
