materials

Yardage is based on 42"-wide fabric

FOR HOUSE BLOCKS

60 4½" squares from assorted for blocks

8 strips 2½" x WOF (width of fabric) of white fabric (cut into 120 2½" squares)

SASHING STRIPS & BORDERS

5 strips cut 2½" x WOF (sashing strips)

4 strips cut 3½" x WOF (border)

BINDING ½ yard

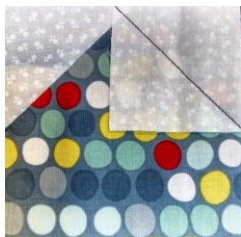
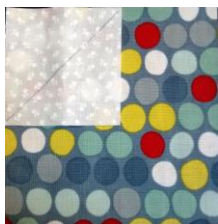
BACKING 1½ yards

BATTING (45" x 52")

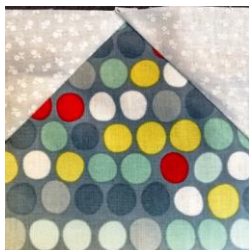
FINISHED SIZE: 41" x 47"

making the blocks

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the white 2½" square. Place the marked square on the upper right corner of the print 4½" square, right sides together, align the raw edges. Sew on the marked lines; trim excess corner fabric ¼" from stitching line.



Add another square to the upper left corner as described above.

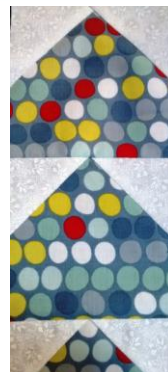


Finished house block

assembling the quilt

Arrange 10 house blocks with the roofs pointing in one direction and sew the blocks together to form a vertical row.

Make six vertical rows.



SASHING STRIPS

Measure the length of the rows and use that measurement to cut the sashing strips for use between your rows.

Sew the rows and sashing strips together. Press the seams towards the sashing strips.

Using the same measurement you used for the sashing strips, cut TWO of the border strips to that measurement and sew to the right and left side of your top.

Cut the remaining 2 border strips and sew to the top and bottom. Press towards the border strips.

Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Baste the layers together. Quilt as desired. Add the binding and a label. T
