

MEET IN THE MIDDLE

This makes a 36" x 48" quilt.

Cut 9 2½" x WOF for background. Sub-cut these in half along the center fold.
(⅔ yard)

Cut 54 2½" x 10" segments for center strips.
These should be a variety of colors and/or prints. (14 WOF's or scrappy variety from smaller cuts of fabric)

Join three color/print strips into a long row.
Then sew one background strip onto each end of the row, forming a circle.

This will measure close to 48", depending on the original width of the background fabric. With a scissor, cut the background piece anywhere you'd like, making sure you vary the cuts. Leave at least 6" of background on either end.

Next you sew the strips together. The varied cuts make the up and down motion.
