Rosalie Dace – contract, accommodations schedule etc. to be handled
by Lindi and Marca. Date proposed for 2018. QA is not combining with us.

Hollis Chatelaine – **AQSues will be handling all details of this artist's visit, contract is signed. SBSQC wants to NOT handle this artist, however, contract is signed.** Proposed date the week before Thanksgiving 2018.
Sue is working with Sherry to find venue for classes, and Sue will house her. **Seri informed AQS members that those people who were registered for the 2016 workshop will have first priority for the 2018 workshop.**
