## Clue \#1:

## Step A

Select the following strips:
$\square 2$ (1) strips $51 / 2 "(4 ") \times$ WOF Medium
2 (1) strips $51 / 2 "(4 ")$ x WOF Accent
Stack a Medium strip and an Accent strip right sides together.
Subcut into $51 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "(4 " \times 4 ")$ squares. You need a total of 10 stacked pairs of squares.

## Step B

Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each pair of squares. Stitch $1 / 4 "$ on each side of the drawn line.
Cut on the line. Press to the darker fabric. Trim to 5 " ( $3^{1 / 2 "}$ ) square.
You now have 20 half-square triangle (HST) units of Medium/Accent.


## Step C

Select the following strips:
2 strips 5" (3 1/2") x WOF Background 1 strip 2" ( $1 \times 1 / 2 "$ ) x WOF Accent
Stack the Accent strip on top of one of the
Background strips right sides together. Sew, then press seam to the Accent to make a strip-set.

Hint: Stack the other Background strip on top of the strip-set. This is so that you can cut both pieces at the same time.
Subcut into 2" ( $1^{1 / 2 ")}$ ) rectangles. You need a total of 20 $5 " \times 2 "(31 / 2 " \times 11 / 2 ")$ Background pieces and 20 $6^{1 / 2 "} \times 2 "\left(4^{1 / 2 "} \times 11 / 2 "\right)$ Background/Accent strip-set pieces.


## Step D

Sew the Background piece to one of the two Accent sides of each HST unit. Press to the Accent.
Sew the strip-set piece to the adjacent side, so that the Background portion lines up with the remaining Accent side of the HST unit. Press to the Background. You should now have 20 pieces that are $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}(41 / 2 ")$ square.
