## *Clue* #2

## <u>Step E</u>

Select the following strips:

- □ 1 strip 5" (3 ½") x WOF Accent
- □ 2 (1 <sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>2</sub>) strips 3 <sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub>" (2 <sup>1</sup>⁄<sub>4</sub>") x WOF Focus

Subcut Accent into 5" x 5" ( $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ ") squares. You need 5 Accent squares. Subcut Focus into  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " ( $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{4}$ ") squares. You need a total of 20 Focus squares.

Take remaining Accent strip and cut 8 2" (1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>") squares. Set aside for <u>Clue 5 Step L</u>.

Step F

Making sure the **Focus** fabric is wrong side up on the corner of the **Accent** fabric, sew along the diagonal. Press open and trim two bottom layers of corner.

Repeat on opposite corner, then do the other two corners. You will notice that the Accent square "floats" inside the Focus sides. Do not try to force <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seams to meet with the points of the Accent box!

You will need 5 Square-in-a-Square units in Focus/Accent.
