Step G


Select the following strips:

- \Box 2 (1 ¹/₂) strips 6 ¹/₂" (4 ¹/₂") x WOF Focus
- □ 2 (1 ¹⁄₂) strips 6 ¹⁄₂" (4 ¹⁄₂") x WOF Background

Cut out the templates on the dotted lines for Center Triangle and Side Triangle.

<u>Step H</u>


Take each strip of **Focus** fabric and fold in half lengthwise, right sides together. Using the Center Triangle template, cut out 10 triangles, alternating the direction of the template from point-up to pointdown. You should now have 20 **Focus** Center Triangles.



Take each strip of **Background** fabric and fold in half lengthwise, right sides together. They <u>must</u> be <u>right sides together</u> to create left and right sides.

Note: To create the Triangle-In-a-Rectangle block, it is <u>very</u> important to sew <u>a</u> <u>scant ¼" seam</u>. If you have problems with doing this, you might want to make the straight side of the side triangles 1/8" larger, sew, press, and then trim to size.

Using the Side Triangle template, cut out 20 triangles, alternating the direction of the template from point-up to point-down. You should now have 20 **Background** <u>Left</u> Center Triangles and 20 **Background** <u>Right</u> Center Triangles.



<u>Step I</u>

Sew **Background** <u>Left</u> Side Triangle to **Focus** Center Triangle as shown in the figure. Make sure right sides are together! Press to the **Background** Side Triangle.



Sew **Background** <u>Right</u> Side Triangle to **Focus** Center Triangle as shown in the next figure. Make sure right sides are together! Press to the **Background** Side Triangle. Trim to 5" x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ") if required.

You should now have 20 5" x 6 ¹/₂" (3 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂") Trianglein-a-Rectangle blocks of **Focus/Background**.
