## Clue \#3

## Step G

Select the following strips:
$\square 2\left(1^{1 / 2}\right)$ strips $61 / 2 \prime \prime\left(4^{1 / 2 \prime}\right)$ x WOF Focus
$\square 2\left(1^{1 ⁄ 2}\right)$ strips $61 / 2 "\left(4^{1 / 2 \prime}\right)$ x WOF Background
Cut out the templates on the dotted lines for Center Triangle and Side Triangle.

## Step H

Take each strip of Focus fabric and fold in half lengthwise, right sides together. Using the Center Triangle template, cut out 10 triangles, alternating the direction of the template from point-up to pointdown. You should now have 20 Focus
 Center Triangles.

Take each strip of Background fabric and fold in half lengthwise, right sides together. They must be right sides together to create left and right sides.

Note: To create the Triangle-In-a-Rectangle block, it is very important to sew a scant $1 / 4$ " seam. If you have problems with doing this, you might want to make the straight side of the side triangles $1 / 8$ " larger, sew, press, and then trim to size. Using the Side Triangle template, cut out 20 triangles, alternating the direction of the template from point-up to point-down. You should now have 20 Background Left Center Triangles and 20 Background Right Center Triangles.

## Step I



Sew Background Left Side Triangle to Focus Center Triangle as shown in the figure.
Make sure right sides are together! Press to the Background Side Triangle.


Sew Background Right Side Triangle to Focus Center Triangle as shown in the next figure. Make sure right sides are together! Press to the Background Side Triangle. Trim to 5 " $\times 61 / 2 "\left(31 / 2 " \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ if required.

You should now have 20 $5 " \times 61 / 2 "(31 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 ")$ Triangle-in-a-Rectangle blocks of Focus/Background.
