Community quilt pattern in two sizes

## COMFORT <br> LAP

1 yard total of lights $1-1 / 2$ yards total of lights
1 yard total of darks
1-1/2 yards total of darks
1/3 yard for binding
1/2 yard for binding

Both quilts are made with five inch "charm" squares. The quilt can be made with just one light and one dark fabric, but we suggest that you use various fabrics in the one light or one dark color so that there are variations. For example: three various light yellows and three various medium to dark blues. It can also be made with all of the "light" squares in a uniform fabric and the "dark" squares in various other colors. Or each plus sign could be a different color!

Comfort quilt size is 36 by 49.5 inches. Eight blocks across and eleven down for a total of 88 five inch squares. No borders needed. Five binding strips cut 2-1/4 inch by WOF.

1/3 yard each of six fabrics will allow you to cut 90 five inch squares and vary the fabrics throughout while keeping the colors coordinated.

Lap quilt size is 45 by 63 inches. Ten blocks across and fourteen blocks down for a total of 140 five inch squares. No borders needed. Six binding strips cut 2-1/4 inch by WOF.
$1 / 2$ yard each of 6 fabrics will allow you to cut 144 five inch squares.
