Framed Charms Quilt

36" x 48"

Yardage:

Focus Fabrics – forty-eight 5" charm squares Fabric A and Fabric B – 14" (1/2 yard) of each Binding – 12 1/2" (3/8 yard)

Cutting:

Fabric A

- Cut three 2" x WOF strips; crosscut into twelve 2" x 9 1/2" rectangles
- Cut four 2" x WOF strips; crosscut into twelve
 2" x 12 1/2" rectangles

Fabric B

Cut same as Fabric A

Binding

• Cut five 2 ½" x WOF strips

Block Assembly:

4-Patch Centers

Sew two 5" charm squares together into pairs. Join two pairs together forming a 4-patch block. Blocks should

measure 9 ½" square. Repeat with remaining charm squares to create a total of twelve 4-patch blocks.

Frame Block Set 1:


Sew one 9 1/2" rectangle from Fabric A to each side of the remaining six 4-patch squares. Then sew one 12 1/2"" rectangle from Fabric A to the top and bottom.


Frame Block Set 2:


Sew one 9 1/2" rectangle from Fabric B to the top and bottom of six 4-patch squares. Then sew one 12 1/2" rectangle from Fabric B to each side.

Assembling the Quilt:

Alternate the blocks checkerboard fashion turning the blocks so that all the longer rectangles in Block Set 1 are horizontal and all the longer rectangles in Block Set 2 are vertical. Now stitch them all together checkerboard style. Press.
