Simple Bargello Quilt

36" x 48"

Yardage:

Quilt Top: Twelve assorted 4 ½" X WOF strips (Strips must be 41" in length or longer)

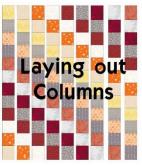
Binding: 3/8 yard cut into 5 - 2 ½" x WOF strips

Quilt Assembly:

- 1. Arrange strips in whichever order you prefer and sew all strips together lengthwise along the WOF.
- 2. Next, sew the top strip to the bottom strip to create a "tube".
- 3. Keeping the right sides of the fabrics facing each other, lay your tube flat and cut the tube into 4 ½" strips. You should now have nine 4 ½" wide tubes.
- 4. From one tube, choose a seam to "un-sew" or "rip out". Choose the seam above your favorite design as this will be the start of the top left-hand side of your quilt and will run down the middle of your quilt.
- 5. From the next tube, "un-sew" the seam between the bottom two fabrics in the first column.
- 6. Continue in this manner for each remaining tube. Refer to the diagram as needed to get the desired layout pattern.
- 7. Once you have all columns laid out, press alternating columns in opposite directions and sew them together.







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
