Business Meeting Minutes

October 12, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 by President Judy Anderson. Present were Judy Ramos and Kath Beecher, Vice Presidents, Seri Mylchreest, Treasurer, Mary Liebsch, Secretary and Susan Bermel, Parliamentarian.

Minutes were approved, no corrections.

Treasurer's Report- Seri reports the income for September 2016 was \$5801.75. Expenses paid in September totaled \$6215.93. The income includes fees for Education workshops and the Calendar fundraiser. The expenses paid included purchase of a projector and Education program teacher professional fees and travel expenses. The net loss for the month \$414.18.

The balance of the checking account as of 9/30/16 was \$23932.50. The CD balance was \$9043.37.

Judy and Kath reported about Kamp Sew Alot.
