## SUBURBAN CHARMERS

35 charm squares or assorted 5 " squares for houses $1 / 4$ yard of blue or assorted blues for sky
Scraps of greens for grass
$3 / 4$ yard of green or contrast color for sashes and borders

Cut three 2 3/4" " strips x WoF of blue fabric for sky.

Sub-cut into 702 3/4" squares.
Cut $3511 / 5^{\prime \prime} \times 5$ " strips of green or assorted greens for front lawn.
cut four 2 1/2" strips $\times$ WoF for sashing.
cut four 3 1/2' strips $\times$ WoF for borders.

| Binding | $1 / 2$ yard |
| :--- | :--- |
| Backing | $11 / 2$ yards |

For each sky, diagonally stitch a small blue square on the right upper corner of a house square. Trim and press open. Repeat on the upper left corner.
(this is the same method as flying geese block)

Sew a front lawn on the bottom of each house.

Arrange and join seven house blocks together to form a column. Make five columns.
Measure the length of the columns and use that measurement to cut the sashing strips.
Sew the columns and sashing strips together.
Press the seams towards the sashing.
Measure and attach your two side borders.
Measure and attach your top and the bottom borders.
